



Closing gender employment gaps brings economic gains


Employment to population ratios, 15 to 64 year-olds, 2000-2021


the average increase in real GDP per capita to be gained from tapping into the potential of female workers and closing the gender employment and working hours gaps in OECD countries by 2060

- improved design of tax and benefits system
- reduced occupational and sectoral segregation


Must also recognise that gender inequalities are interconnected...



61% of OECD countries now practice gender budgeting

the number of OECD countries practicing gender budgeting has almost doubled in recent years

How can gender budgeting help?



Direction setting: Prioritises key policy measures to close gender gaps

Greater transparency on how budget measures impact different groups of society

Helps **remove inequalities** from budget measures

Improves the effectiveness of the budget in meeting strategic objectives relating to gender equality


